

Retiring President to Discuss Pet Companions Club Changes

The Pet Companions Club of PebbleCreek will hold its first regular membership meeting of the Fall on Wednesday, November 6, 2024. We will meet at 3:00 PM in Room 100 of the Eagles Nest Activities Center. All PebbleCreek residents, whether club members or not, are invited to attend.

This year we are electing the President, Treasurer, and two Directors at Large with nominations due at our November meeting. This will result in at least two new members joining the Board.
