



RECOVERING YOUR LOST PET

- Notify Patrol
- Post information and your pets photo on PebbleCreek groups.io. Also post on the PebbleCreek Residents and the PebbleCreek Residents Animals and Pets facebook pages.
- Post information in the lost pet section of the following websites: www.craigslist.com, www.lostandpound.com, www.petfinder.com, www.petharbor.com, www.fidofinder.com, www.lostmydoggie.com.

- Contact Maricopa County Animal Control, (602)506-7387. The West Valley facility is located in Phoenix at 2500 S 27th Avenue (27th Avenue and Lower Buckeye). They recommend visiting the shelter every two days to look for your pet. You can also post your pet on their lost and found pets map tool: <https://www.maricopa.gov/162/Lost-Found-Pet>
- Place lost pet notices (written description and photo) at area veterinary hospitals and any other locations that will accept them (pet stores, grocery stores, etc).
- Visit the Arizona Humane Society's Sunnyslope Facility Admissions Department, 13th Avenue and W Hatcher Road, and ask to see the lost pets in their Second Chance Animal Hospital. They take in more than 100 animals a day and can't verify over the phone. If your pet has been missing for several days or weeks, view the adoptable pets on their website. Found pets with no ID and unclaimed are put up for adoption.
